We fed more than 120 orphan children living in Niwaranpur Orphan, age Home in Ranchi many times and also distributed books & sports items.

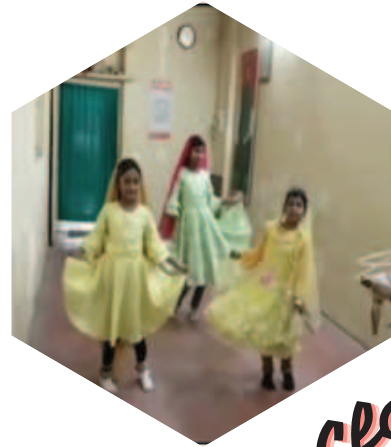


The Trust is running a regular Free Homeopathy health clinic with eminent Doctors of Ranchi in our trust premises to date

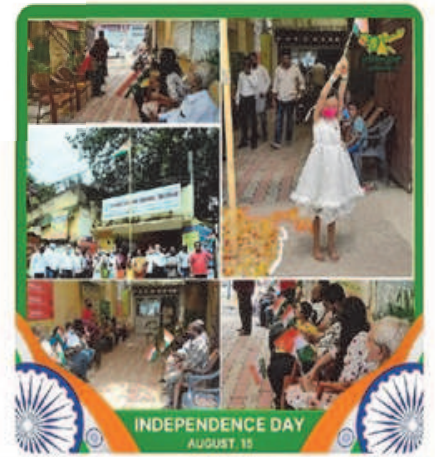
